Encourage my child to try their best so they can reach their full 	 Pupils As a pupil at St Clare's I will do my best to: Be ready, respectful and safe in school and on school trips. Arrive in school on time and ready to learn. Try my best to do my work and ask for help if I need it. Wear the correct school uniform and bring any extra kit to school if needed. Bring all the equipment I need to school each day. Be friendly and caring towards other children and adults. Listen to instructions from the adults at school and follow the school rules. Do my homework and bring it back to school on time. Look after school equipment and be respectful of the school environment.
 Offer extra curricular activities that suppor your child's development. Promote high standards of behaviour so we a maintain a safe environment for all children. Offer your child opportunities to develop a sense of responsibility, form healthy social relationships and build their self-esteem. Set homework that supports the delivery of curriculum and mark it where appropriate. Offer opportunities for parents and carers to get involved in school life. Make sure communication with the school is respectful, and that I make every reasonable effort to address the concerns to the appropriate member of staff. Raise any concerns in an appropriate manner, not in a public forum including on social media. Understand that I should communicate with staff during core school hours, and although they may at times respond outside of those hours, I can't always expect that. Make sure that that my child completes their homework on time. Read and follow the school's policies.
